- Technical seminar on introduction to data acquisition
- Track will close at 5pm - Quiet rule in effect!

3. TRACK

The circuit is originally 875 m long, with a minimum width of 8 meters, featuring 14 bends.

The competitor is responsible for the cleanliness of the paddock area allocated to him, including the collection of waste. The competitor must dispose of waste in accordance with environmental standards (paper, food in garbage cans, toxic liquids such as oil or gasoline in designated places). Anyone who does not respect the cleanliness instruction may be refused registration for a subsequent event and will have to reimburse the decontamination costs if necessary.

Please see the organizers prior to parking or risk being moved. No dumping of tires or oil in the garbage barrels. We do have an oil drum for used oil and a used tire area though we do prefer you take them with you. Regular garbage only in the garbage barrels please. Broken tents, chairs, tables or BBQs are not to be left on site

Any competitor installed in a paddock space already allocated to another competitor, or overrunning on a neighboring paddock, will be obliged to vacate this paddock immediately, regardless of the activity on the track at the time. ANY REFUSAL TO COMPLY WITH A PADDOCK RELEASE REQUEST MAY LEAD TO THE DISQUALIFICATION OF THE COMPETITOR WITHOUT FURTHER NOTICE, AT THE SOLE DISCRETION OF THE ORGANIZERS.

4. PARKING

You must obtain your location from the organizers before setting up. You just have to ask the staff who will be designated for this purpose. Only one location per competitor is allocated. All vehicles must be parked in the place outside the paddock area designated by the organizer. Paddock spaces will be selected at the time of online registration. It will be allocated on a first come, first served bases.

Update: Quiet generators are required at all times as there is noise restriction that will be strictly enforced.

Rough camping is available at the track and will be managed by track owner at time of arrival. Camping is not allowed in the pit spots.

5. REGISTRATION

The regular registration period will be available online on cupckarts.com. Additional fees will be applied after Monday July 14th, 2025, at 23:59.

6. KART NUMBERS

Unless you already have your number reserved from the National website of CKNA, the participants will be able to reserve their kart number at registration and will be allocated on a “first come first serve basis”. There will not be any constraints to the kart number you select for the 2025 CKCD season. The only number participants will not be able to choose is the #1 as it is reserved for the series’ champion.

7. CREDENTIALS

Credential is done at the track from Thursday 13h00 a.m. to 17:00, Friday 8h00-17h00 and Saturday from 7h00 to 8h00 am on the day of the event. All persons admitted to the site (officials, organizers, drivers and team members) must sign the waiver form. In the case of minors (under 18); a parent or guardian must sign the waiver form on behalf of the minor. Drivers who have registered by the online procedure, as well as their teammates, must also sign the waiver of credential hours.

a. CKNA RULES APPLICABLE UNLESS THESE SPECIFIC ADDITION IN THIS SECTION

i. HELMET CUSHIONS:

1. As per CKNA rules

ii. SUITS AND ACCESSORIES

1. SUITS:

- a. Only approved karting suits will be allowed.

2. Gloves and shoes

- a. Only abrasion resistant and approved equipment for karting will be allowed.

iii. CLUTCHES

1. Briggs 2025 rules

iv. TIRES

1. Vega Red tires marked KK available at online registration.
2. See previous table at section 8 for the details per classes.

v. Supplemental sporting rules

Cutting the track: Racing must stay within track limits defined by the painted lines or pavement design if paint lines aren't available. Curbs are not part of the track. Racing outside the limits may be penalised even if there hasn't been position was gained or preserved.
