The circuit is just about longer than 1 km long, featuring 10 corners. All events will run counter clockwise.

The competitor is responsible for the cleanliness of the paddock area allocated to him, including the collection of waste. The competitor must dispose of waste in accordance with

environmental standards (paper, food in garbage cans, toxic liquids such as oil or gasoline in designated places). Anyone who does not respect the cleanliness instruction may be refused registration for a subsequent event and will have to reimburse the decontamination costs if necessary.

Any competitor installed in a paddock space already allocated to another competitor, or overrunning on a neighboring paddock, will be obliged to vacate this paddock immediately, regardless of the activity on the track at the time. ANY REFUSAL TO COMPLY WITH A Paddock RELEASE REQUEST MAY LEAD TO THE DISQUALIFICATION OF THE COMPETITOR WITHOUT FURTHER NOTICE, AT THE SOLE DISCRETION OF THE ORGANIZERS.

4. PARKING

You must obtain your location from the organizers before setting up. You just have to ask the staff who will be designated for this purpose. Only one location per competitor is allocated. All vehicles must be parked in the place outside the paddock area designated by the organizer. Paddock spaces will be selected at the time of online registration. It will be allocated on a first come, first served bases

5. ELIGIBILITY

Canadian drivers must hold a club and/or Provincial license issued by or recognized by Auto sport Québec or by CASC-OR. American or international drivers must hold a US license or CKNA membership and of the current year or any other license recognized by Auto sport Québec or by the CASC-OR. All drivers must go through the CKNA online site for registration; www.cupkarts.com

6. REGISTRATION

The regular registration period will be open July 4th 2022. Additional late registration fees will be applied from July 17th, 2022, at 11:59 p.m. Late registrations will be accepted until July, 20th and in the morning of the race weekend. No registration will be accepted after the end of the accreditation period, i.e., after 8:00 a.m. Race Day July 23rd, 2022 or 8:00 a.m. Race Day July 24th, 2022

7. KART NUMBERS

The participants will be able to reserve their kart number at registration and will be allocated on a "first come first serve basis". There will not be any constraints to the kart number you select for the 2022 CKCD season. The only number participants will not be able to choose is the #1 as it is reserved for the serie's champion.

8. CREDENTIALS

Credential is done at the track from Friday 8h00 a.m. to 17:00 and Saturday from 7h30 to 8h00 am on the day of the event. All persons admitted to the site (officials, organizers, pilots

and team members) must sign the waiver form. In the case of minors (under 18); a parent or guardian must sign the waiver form on behalf of the minor. Drivers who have registered by the online procedure, as well as their teammates, must also sign the waiver of credential hours. 15. SPECIFIC RULES :

a. CKNA RULES APPLICABLE UNLESS THESE SPECIFIC ADDITION IN THIS SECTION

i. HELMETS:

1. Helmets with SFI certifications will NOT be allowed

ii. HEADNECK CUSHIONS:

1. Headneck cushions are mandatory for all junior (including LIGHT) and CADET classes

2. Headneck cushions are recommended but not mandatory for all other classes

- iii. SUITS AND ACCESSORIES
 - 1. SUITS:
 - a. Only approved karting suits will be allowed
 - 2. Gloves and shoes
 - a. Only abrasion resistant and approved equipment for karting will be allowed
- iv. CHEST PROTECTOR UNDER 13 yo
 - 1. Recommended but not mandatory
- v. RIB PROTECTOR
 - 1. Mandatory for all ages/classes
- vi. PUSH BACK BUMPERS :
 - 1. CKNA rules to be applied.
 - 2. Push back equipment can stay on but no penalty will be given if out of position.
- vii. EXHAUST HEADER
 - 1. In addition to the article 34 of the Canadian Briggs 2022 rulebook, Left side header part #EXF5511 is allowed
- viii. EXHAUST PROTECTION :
 - 1. The header **AND** silencer must be completely wrapped as per article 36 of the Briggs 2022 Canada.
- ix. CLUTCHES
 - 1. Briggs 2022 rules
- x. TYRES
 - 1. Vega Blue ONT tyres available at online registration
 - 2. See previous table at section 8 for the details per classes
- xi. REAR TRACK WIDTH
 - 1. 50 inches max
