The circuit is originally 750 long, with a minimum width of 8 meters, featuring 10 bends. Modifications as seen on the pictures above will add some 4 corners to it. Track direction will be determined.

The competitor is responsible for the cleanliness of the paddock area allocated to him, including the collection of waste. The competitor must dispose of waste in accordance with

environmental standards (paper, food in garbage cans, toxic liquids such as oil or gasoline in designated places). Anyone who does not respect the cleanliness instruction may be refused registration for a subsequent event and will have to reimburse the decontamination costs if necessary.

Please see the organizers prior to parking or risk being moved. No dumping of tires or oil in the garbage barrels. We do have an oil drum for used oil and a used tire area though we do prefer you take them with you. Regular garbage only in the garbage barrels please. Broken tents, chairs, tables or BBQs are not to be left on site

Any competitor installed in a paddock space already allocated to another competitor, or overrunning on a neighboring paddock, will be obliged to vacate this paddock immediately, regardless of the activity on the track at the time. ANY REFUSAL TO COMPLY WITH A PADDOCK RELEASE REQUEST MAY LEAD TO THE DISQUALIFICATION OF THE COMPETITOR WITHOUT FURTHER NOTICE, AT THE SOLE DISCRETION OF THE ORGANIZERS.

4. PARKING

You must obtain your location from the organizers before setting up. You just have to ask the staff who will be designated for this purpose. Only one location per competitor is allocated. All vehicles must be parked in the place outside the paddock area designated by the organizer. Paddock spaces will be selected at the time of online registration. It will be allocated on a first come, first served bases.

Camping is available from Wednesday 5th at 9am, gate closes at 9pm. RVs are \$25 per night. Tents \$10 per night. Sunday night, all campers have to be off site by 8pm. Please contact Che Smith on 613-276-8686 or che@nonstop-racing.com to book your spot prior to coming to the track. First come first spots reserved. Camping must be in the camping area and not in the paddock. Toy haulers are accepted. No loud generators after 7pm or before 8am. 😥 No dumping of any waste water on site! There is no fresh water available on site so please fill up before you arrive. No dumping of used gas bottles on site. Regular garbage must be bagged. NO CAMPING WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE PADDOCK

5. ELIGIBILITY

Canadian drivers must hold a club and/or Provincial license issued by or recognized by Auto sport Québec. American or international drivers must hold a US license or CKNA membership and of the current year or any other license recognized by Auto sport Québec. All drivers must go through the CKNA online site <u>www.cupkarts.com</u> for registration.

6. REGISTRATION

The regular registration period will be available online on cupckarts.com. Additional fees will be applied from July 1st, 2023, at 23:59. Late registrations fees will be applied from this date until race weekend. No registration will be accepted after the end of the registration period, i.e., after 8:00 a.m. Race Day July 9th, 2023.

7. KART NUMBERS

Unless you already have your number reserved from the National website of CKNA, the participants will be able to reserve their kart number at registration and will be allocated on a "first come first serve basis". There will not be any constraints to the kart number you select for the 2023 CKCD season. The only number participants will not be able to choose is the #1 as it is reserved for the series' champion.

8. CREDENTIALS

Credential is done at the track from Thursday 12h00 a.m. to 17:00, Friday 8h00-17h00 and Saturday from 7h00 to 8h00 am on the day of the event. All persons admitted to the site (officials, organizers, drivers and team members) must sign the waiver form. In the case of minors (under 18); a parent or guardian must sign the waiver form on behalf of the minor. Drivers who have registered by the online procedure, as well as their teammates, must also sign the waiver of credential hours.
