- No starting of karts all day.
- No access to the track granted
- Paddock access and preparation

Friday – June 26th, 2026 – Practice – 8:00 to 16:00 (Approx.)

- Track opens at 6:30
- Credential package pick-up – closes at 17h00
- Quiet paddock, you can only start the engines at the pre-grids
- Registration and tire distribution – opens at 7h00 and closes at 17h00 – Must be registered to go on track
- Track access granted for open practice – around 5 sessions estimated per classes
- Registration and tire distribution/markings.
- Pre-technical inspection
- Mandatory driver's meeting with prizes draw – 17h00-18h00

Saturday – June 27th, 2026 – Race 1 - 7:00 to 17:00 (Approx.)

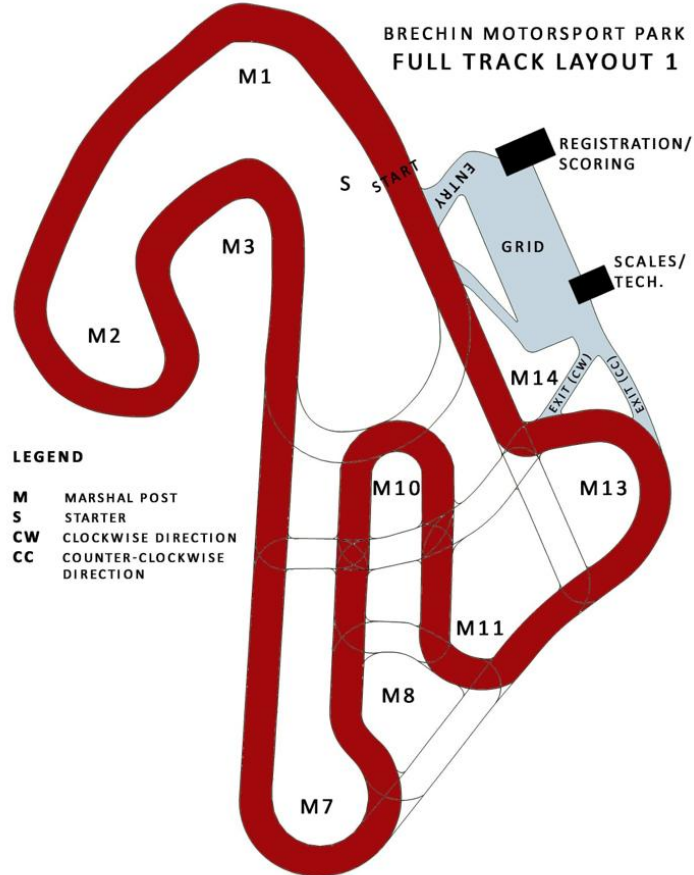
- Track opens at 6:30

3. TRACK



Located:

Brechin Motorsport Park
2687 Concession Road A,
Brechin, ON L0K 1B0, CA.

The circuit is 0.82 km long, with a minimum width of 8 meters, featuring 10 bends. All events will run counterclockwise.

The competitor is responsible for the cleanliness of the paddock area allocated to him, including the collection of waste. The competitor must dispose of waste in accordance with environmental standards (paper, food in garbage cans, toxic liquids such as oil or gasoline in designated places). Anyone who does not respect the cleanliness instruction may be refused registration for a subsequent event and will have to reimburse the decontamination costs if necessary.

Any competitor installed in a paddock space already allocated to another competitor, or overrunning on a neighboring paddock, will be obliged to vacate this paddock immediately,

regardless of the activity on the track at the time. ANY REFUSAL TO COMPLY WITH A PADDOCK RELEASE REQUEST MAY LEAD TO THE DISQUALIFICATION OF THE COMPETITOR WITHOUT FURTHER NOTICE, AT THE SOLE DISCRETION OF THE ORGANIZERS.

4. PARKING

You must obtain your location from the organizers before setting up. You just must ask the staff who will be designated for this purpose. Only one location per competitor is allocated. All vehicles must be parked in the place outside the paddock area designated by the organizer. Paddock spaces will be selected at the time of online registration. It will be allocated on a first come, first served bases.

Rough camping is available thru registration. CKNA will provide location space and planning.

Quiet generators are always required as there is noise restriction that will be strictly enforced.

5. REGISTRATION

The regular registration period will be available online on cupkarts.com. No registration will be accepted after the end of the accreditation period, i.e., after 8:00 a.m. Race Day June 27th, 2026 or June 28th if one day racing.

6. KART NUMBERS

Unless you already have your number reserved from the National website of CKNA, the participants will be able to reserve their kart number at registration and will be allocated on a "first come first serve basis". There will not be any constraints to the kart number you select for the 2026 CKCD season. The only number participants will not be able to choose is the #1 as it is reserved for the series' champion.

7. CREDENTIALS

Credential is done at the track from Thursday 12h00 a.m. to 20:00, Friday 7h00-13h00 and Saturday from 7h00 to 8h00 am on the day of the event. All persons admitted to the site (officials, organizers, drivers and team members) must sign the waiver form. In the case of minors (under 18); a parent or guardian must sign the waiver form on behalf of the minor. Drivers who have registered by the online procedure, as well as their teammates, must also sign the waiver of credential hours.

And will be controlled using an appropriate control device. The fuel checked will be that available at this station.

Beginning in 2026, CKNA Canada will be conducting random fuel sampling, on-site water tests, and full laboratory verification when required.

Clear Standards for 2026:

CKNA will conduct random fuel pulls at all events

Any competitor may be selected at any time

Samples may be screened on-site and/or submitted to our laboratory partner

Competitors must comply immediately with any request for a fuel sample

Results will be recorded and maintained for series integrity

Any detected additive thru lab tests will result in a lifetime ban from CKNA

a. CKNA RULES APPLICABLE UNLESS THESE SPECIFIC ADDITION IN THIS SECTION

i. HELMET CUSHIONS:

1. As per CKNA rules

ii. SUITS AND ACCESSORIES

1. SUITS:

a. Only approved karting suits will be allowed.

2. Gloves and shoes

a. Only abrasion resistant and approved equipment for karting will be allowed.

iii. CLUTCHES

1. Briggs 2026 rules

iv. TIRES

1. Vega Red tires marked KK are the tire for the weekend.

2. See previous table at section 8 for the details per classes

3. Happy hour tires: If new tires will be used, they'll be your race tires for the weekend and will be scanned for verification.

4. If driver has chosen to race Sunday only, the warmup tires MUST be the same scanned set for the official racing sessions.
